Mrs Frost's Message

July is always a very busy and exciting period for us with competitions and exam preparation leading into the exam period proper. It is always lovely to see the students blossom over three days of exam preparation and to observe how much more confident they are by the end!

The first week of the holidays was devoted to SFD comps. Having seen all the items at the dress rehearsal I was sure they would be lovely and they certainly represented RBG amazingly well! I send my congratulations to all competitors and a huge thank you to their coaches and their parents for supporting them so well. Amongst many placings I must congratulate Laura Young for winning the major classical scholarship where she joins a large number of former successful RBG dancers! It was her first outing in the scholarship so indeed a wonderful outcome!

This was followed by 5 days of exam preparation and coaching and as mentioned the students all responded exceptionally well and by the third day there was a marked improvement and they're much more ready to enter the exam room and achieve their best. During these days we not only cover the classwork but are able to spend more time on their dances and to practise the etiquette including how to enter the room, where stand when not dancing and generally how to move around the room in the correct manner. All this creates much greater confidence in the students and is well worth the many hours we spent here! I would like to thank the parent helpers who were here every day to ensure the teachers who looked after with cups of tea and lovely lunches and also to man the phone and ensure all the students were here for their classes. Thank you also to our student assistants and of course the teachers whose dedication to the students is phenomenal. We couldn't run these days without your help so thank you! We have now had all the jazz exams as well as the first lot of classical and tap with the final set of SFD exams due this Sunday and then two days of RAD exams follow during the week!

Once this is over we will begin work on presentation evening which is our annual showcase of class work and our awards night. I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible at this event as it is a delightful way for you to see what your children have been doing throughout the year and how the work progresses from our youngest students to our most senior! Information has gone out via operoo.

Once Presentation Evening is over we turn our attention to the concert. This will start with a costume fitting day on Sunday the 10th September where all levels and styles will have costumes fitted or if new costumes are needed they will be measured for accurate sizing! The senior school will be performing an abstract neoclassical ballet Divertimento set to Mozart's beautiful music, and then all classical levels from level 5 up will be part of "The Enchanted Tapestry" which is the feature story ballet for the year. Junior ballet from kinder through to level 4 classes will be performing "The Doll Shop"; jazz classes will have a Broadway theme and the tap classes will honour the traditions of the past great tappers from many Hollywood movies and musicals. They will also be contemporary and character dances in the first part of the programme.



We are planning to run a fun dance workshop on the 20th of August for middle and senior students. There will be classical classes taken by Flynn Stelfox who is a graduate of the Australian Ballet School and currently performing with Milwaukee ballet in the United States of America. The class will include being taught a variation from one of the great ballets and the theme will be how to develop style and flow! There will also be contemporary classes which will be taken by Joanna Done who recently ran our acro classes while Mr Sam was away! I hope that many of you will be able to attend as it should be a really fun day and give you something different to think about in your classes. Details will be coming out shortly!
