#### STAGE MAKEUP

Stage Makeup remains the same as previous years. Info is available on the website under the 'Parent Zone' tab.

- Foundation 1 shade darker than skin tone
- Eye Shadow 3 Shades Dark Brown, Beige and White/Cream (No Shimmers please)
- Blush Brick/Terracotta red, not pink or bright red
- Lipstick Red (cherry red)
- Powder pressed or loose
- Eyelashes from Level 5 (La Fille) up medium length
- Eye liner Liquid is recommended Black
- Mascara Black

## ALL FULL DRESS REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES

The following require FULL costume to be worn – no excuses –make up is NOT necessary for juniors at either rehearsal. Dancers must arrive well in advance of their start time to change into costumes and MUST have their hair correctly and immaculately groomed so that headdresses can be worn and any hair changes can be practiced.

### PROFESSIONAL COSTUME PHOTOS

On Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> December, at the full dress rehearsal, we have organised We Photograph to take individual photos of your children in costume. This is an optional service which we are providing, it is not compulsory. A photography studio will be set up at the community hall. Parents will then have the opportunity to purchase 5x7" prints for \$15 and digital files for \$20 Each. Images will be available online with payment made directly to We Photograph.

Where: Community Centre next door to ballet studios.

If you are interested in having a photo of your child in costume, you will need to ensure that you come either 30 mins prior to your rehearsal time, or be prepared to wait after your scheduled rehearsal time for a photo to be taken. The photography can only be taken before/after your child's rehearsal piece, and it is imperative that the rehearsal schedule not be interrupted, as delays will then impact on the running of the whole day.



#### **DIRECTIONS TO AND AT KARRALYKA THEATRE**

The Karralyka address is Mines Road Ringwood. Please enter through Mines road and there is plenty of parking to the right. The **NEW** stage door entry is to the left before the main building near the new portable – look for our signs. All Students are to use this entry, and exit. Students will then be directed to their allocated dressing rooms, which are:

- Kinder to SFD 4 new portables behind the Theatre
- SFD 5 and SFD 6 Dressing Room 1
- 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year Grade 6 Dressing Room 2
- All Boys Understage
- Grade 7 and above Dressing Room 3


